


• If war is so destructive and causes so much misery, why does it continue?




The wars that Africa did *not* have...

• In 1978-79, Tanzania invaded Uganda.




• In 1998-2000, there was a border war between Ethiopia and Eritrea.




• Are **your** voting preferences *fixed*?

 How often do you change political parties?







Swiss Find Only \$3.4 Million In Bank Accounts for Mobutu

After a full search, Switzerland's commercial banks say they have found only \$3.4 million belonging to the ousted President of Congo, Mobutu Sese Seko, reputed to be one of the richest men in the world.

The amount turned up is far smaller than the \$8 billion the current Congo Government says Mr. Mobutu had siphoned from his country and deposited in Switzerland during his 32 years in power.

A preliminary inquiry of 12 banks last month turned up nothing. Despite this, the Swiss Government ordered a freeze of Mr. Mobutu's assets, including the luxury mansion he owned here.

After all 406 banks examined their ledgers, just six said they had found any assets belonging to Mr. Mobutu, his family or associates. The bulk of the money located -- about \$3 million -- was found by a single bank, which first reported finding nearly nothing.

Critics have charged that the inquiry was too vague and that it did not cover assets that Mr. Mobutu may have held in other financial institutions.


